

Introduction to School Swimming

Course Overview:

This short 2 hour Introduction to School Swimming course is part of Leisure at Cheltenham and the Network's Swimming Development work. Leisure at Cheltenham are part funding these initiatives as a commitment to working with schools to achieve ongoing swimming improvements for children. The initiatives are in response to an identified need to enhance the teaching and learning within school swimming sessions.
